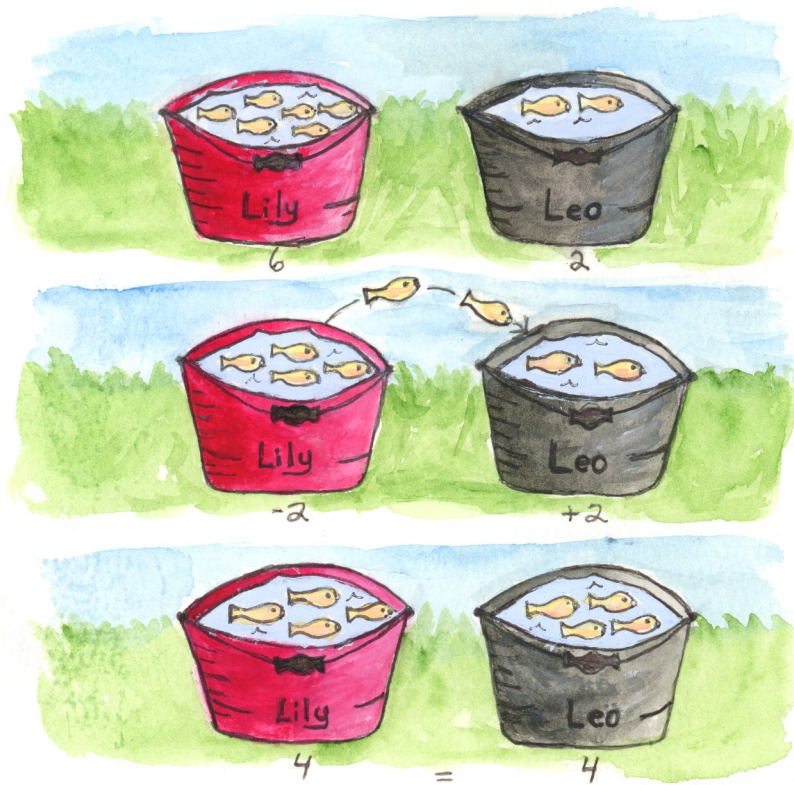


Math Facts

$6 > 2$	Six is greater than two.
$2 < 6$	Two is less than six.
$6 - 1 = 5$	Six minus one equals five.
$2 + 1 = 3$	Two plus one equals three.
$5 > 3$	Five is greater than three.
$3 < 5$	Three is less than five.
$6 - 2 = 4$	Six minus two equals four.
$2 + 2 = 4$	Two plus two equals four.
$4 = 4$	Four equals four.



If Lily gives Leo two fish then
Lily will have four fish.

$$6 - 2 = 4$$

Leo will have four fish.

$$2 + 2 = 4$$

So, Lily and Leo will have the
same number of fish!

$$4 = 4$$
