


Then a cloud starts to cover the stars. Leo counts how many stars he can see now. He counts six stars. Leo wonders how many stars the cloud has covered.



Leo counted twelve stars before the cloud came. Now he counts six.

$$12 - 6 = 6$$

Six stars must be covered by the cloud.



Leo also knows that six plus six equals twelve.

$$6 + 6 = 12$$

Math Facts

12 - 6 = 6	Twelve minus six
	equals six.
